- Enrollment Updates:
  - Goal 100 Kindergarten, 45 1st Grade = 145 students total
  - Need seven applications to be at that goal; need more Kindergarten
  - Families wait to register for myriad of reasons (immunizations, documents, time of year)
  - Using different incentives to try to get more applications new ideas from board
    - "Refer a friend"; immunization drive/health clinic, giveaways
  - Follow up is being done with calls in the early evening (most successful), short text messages, and monthly/bi-monthly newsletter
  - Spanish speaking initiatives Vanessa (office manager)
- Bridge View Families Mother's Day photo shoot
- Vote-Revision to Academic Calendar
  - Want to be aligned with CCSD while keeping true to the "Movement way"
  - Changes:
    - First week of school becomes all half days (originally only 2 days)
    - Inclement weather days separated from Data Days need these days to not be possibly changed
    - End of school year add 3/4 days due to differences in how instruction is calculated (days vs. hours calculated)
    - Vote APPROVED
    - DeAnna will submit this to charter authorizer as an amendment.
- Discussion:
  - John questions about staffing. Are we concerned with staffing shortage right now?
    - We interviewed 6 candidates today 5/6 more coming
    - · Not overly concerned focus was on enrollment, now will work on teachers
    - Teachers unable interview due to state testing; expect more in the coming weeks
    - Want teachers at summer training very important
  - Where are we sourcing candidates?
    - · Local charter schools
    - LinkedIn
  - Changes to teacher pay in CCSD and state levels

- Movement will always look at local districts and "beat" those levels to incentivize recruitment.
- Need to focus on non-teacher roles and making sure those pay levels are appropriate
